



## Early Years Foundation Stage

### Two Year Old Policy

This policy is in line with the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) statutory requirement to review children's progress when a child is aged between two and three. Some two year olds may be eligible to access government funding.

We will:

- Provide a short written summary to parents and /or carers of their child's development in the three prime areas of learning and development.
- Highlight: areas in which a child is progressing well and areas in which some additional support might be needed.
- Describe the activities and strategies we intend to adopt to address any issues or concerns.
- Discuss with parents and/or carers how the summary of development can be used to support learning at home.
- Agree with parents and/or carers when will be the most useful point to provide a summary.
- Have the consent of parents and/or carers to share information directly with other relevant professionals, if they consider this would be helpful.
