

Who qualifies for Free School Meals?

If you receive the following benefits you will be able to claim a meal for your children:

- Income Support
- Income-based Job Seeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- Guarantee Element of State Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit with an annual household income of less than £16,190 and do not get Working Tax Credit

Pupil Premium - Extra Funding for Schools

Did you know that the school receives a Pupil Premium payment for the year in which families are eligible for free school meals and automatically for the following five years? This year it is £900 (expected to rise to £1200 in April 2014) per free school meal pupil. This additional funding will be invested in your child to help them achieve more at school.

Also, did you know that the school receives a Premium of £300 for children of Armed Service Personnel? Please alert your school to ensure that they are aware.
